The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burkdoll at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmembers; Randy Ming, Tim Nedeau, Jennifer Burkdoll and Amy Miner. Shelley Myrick absent. Employees; Ted McDaniel, James Palacio and Bobi Morris. Citizens; Justin Wheeler and Lois Berry.

A motion was made by Councilman Ming to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of November 7, 2017 as written. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0

New Business: Rachelle Mallory requested an extension on her utility bill.

Councilwoman Miner made a motion to approve a utility extension for Rachelle Mallory including all applicable late fees until Monday November 27, 2017. Motion second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Motion made by Councilwoman Burkdoll to adopt ordinance 658 setting truck routes within the corporate limits of the city. Motion second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 1 (Nedeau)

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion at 7:17 p.m. to go in to a ten-minute executive session with Todd Luckman and Ted McDaniel to discuss non-elected personnel issue. Motion second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 7:27 p.m.

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion authorizing the maintenance department to remove and replace an electric pole at 418 S Mason St. for Theel Plumbing. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Ming made a motion approving \$5058.70 plus freight to have Topeka Electric Motors repair a pump for the East lift station. Motion second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion to waive late fees for Cody & Melinda Recob. Motion dies due to lack of second. Late fee will not be remove.

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion to increase Ted McDaniel's wage to \$17.00 an hour. Motion second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Ming made a motion to take parts off the 2008 Impala to repair the 2011 Impala and then list them on Purple Wave to sale them. Motion second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0

Councilwoman Miner made a motion to approve ordinances 43 & 44 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 7:51 p.m. Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0
