A motion was made by Councilwoman Burkdoll to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of May 16, 2017 as written. Motion was second by Councilwoman Myrick. Carried 5 – 0

Old Business: Councilman Ming made a motion to accept the bid of \$2800.00 to clean-up debris from along School Creek submitted by Jesse Lee provided he has proof of liability insurance. Motion second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 5 – 0

New Business: William Brandt was recognized and expressed concerns about the safety of the kids' playing outside because his surrounding neighbors are not mowing their property and he is having problems with snakes and wild animals. Chief McDaniel will address it with the property owners.

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion to approve the purchases a dimmer switch, toolbox shocks and battery in the amount of \$119.00. Motion second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion to approve the purchase of ten signs for the sewer lagoons in the amount of \$150.00 plus shipping. Motion second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0

Mayor Burkdoll will talk to property owners Terri Ullery and James Bennett about easement to place an electric line on their properties for the BNSF Railway.

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion to approve ordinances 21 & 22 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 7:38 p.m. Motion was second by Councilwoman Myrick. Carried 5 – 0
