A motion was made by Councilwoman Miner to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of September 18, 2018 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0

Old Business: Drainage at W 5th and W Elm streets tabled.

New Business: Mayor Miner recognized Dana Weber. Ms Weber discussed a privacy fence.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion at 8:16 p.m. to go in to a twenty-minute executive session with Todd Luckman for attorney/client privilege. Motion second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:36 p.m.

Councilman Ming made a motion at 8:38 p.m. to go return to executive session with Todd Luckman for attorney/client privilege for fifteen minutes. Motion second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:53 p.m.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to have the electric box at the concession stand replaced. Second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion at 9:05 p.m. to go in to a five-minute executive session with Todd Luckman present to discuss non-elected issue. Second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 9:10 p.m.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion that the fire department needs mayor approval prior to doing any out of town standbys. Motion second by Councilman Corpening. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve ordinances 37 & 38 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Nedeau. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Corpening made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 9:16 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0
