**Minutes for the Meeting
of the Governing Body
Tuesday November 20, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Miner at 7:01 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmembers; Randy Ming, Tim Nedeau, Jack Mayfield and Val Corpening, Councilwoman Miner absent. Employees; Ted McDaniel, James Palacio, and Bobi Morris. Citizens; Ken Croucher, Cheyenne Harmon and Cindy Jensen.

A motion was made by Councilman Ming to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of November 6, 2018 as amended. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Old Business: Cindy Jensen reviewed the 2017 audit with the Council.

Drainage at W 5th St and Elm St tabled.

Councilman Ming made a motion to approve the purchase of a 2015 3R10 plus attachments for \$42,365.00 contingent on receiving a municipal lease from the Kansas State Bank with Todd Luckman's approval. Motion second by Councilman Corpening. Carried 3 – 1 (Nedeau)

Cheyenne Harmon gave the Council an update on the Beautification project.

Councilman Nedeau made a motion to approve a \$95.00 ad in the SFT High School Yearbook. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

New Business: Councilman Mayfield made a motion to authorize a 2019 Malt Liquor license for Casey's General Store. Motion second by Councilman Corpening. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to enter into the agreement with Viking Industrial Painting for \$1700.00 per inspection/cleaning of the water tower. Motion second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to authorize the mayor to appoint two councilmembers to attend mediation on December 7, 2018 with attorney Todd Luckman regarding legal issues against Orr/Wyatt Street Scapes, and give those two Councilmembers the power to accept an offer on behalf of the city. Motion second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve ordinances 43 & 44 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 8:26 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Corpening. Carried 4 – 0
