A motion was made by Councilman Mayfield to approve the minutes for the special-call meeting of October 13, 2018 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Corpening. Carried 4 – 0

A motion was made by Councilman Ming to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of October 16, 2018 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 3 – 0 – 1 (Corpening abstain)

Old Business: Drainage at W 5th St and Elm St tabled.

Councilman Ming made a motion to have the clerk to check on a loan at the Kansas State Bank to purchase a 2015 TR310 w/695 hours, a grappler and a Mower. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0.

Councilwoman Miner made a motion at 8:27 p.m. to go in to an additional five-minute executive session with Bobi Morris present to discuss non-elected personnel. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0. Council returned to regular session 8:32 p.m.

Councilwoman Miner made a motion to give all employees a \$50.00 gift card for Thanksgiving. Motion second by Councilman Corpening. Carried 5 – 0

Christmas Dinner will be December 4, 2018 at the Scranton Tavern at 6:30 p.m.

Councilwoman Miner made a motion to approve a lighting contest with 1st place paying the electric charge, 2nd place \$50.00 and 3rd place \$25.00. Councilman Mayfield will give hayrack rides for judging on December 8th and 15th from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Motion second by Councilman Corpening. Carried 5 – 0

The Council meeting for January 1, 2019 will be canceled due to the Holiday.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve ordinances 41 & 42 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0
