**Minutes for the Meeting
of the Governing Body
Tuesday June 5th, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Miner at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmembers; Jack Mayfield, Randy Ming, Tim Nedeau, Val Corpening, and Amy Miner was not present. Employees; Ted McDaniel, James Palacio and Lois Berry. Citizens; Justin Wheeler, Ken Croucher, Rich Woolverton, and Kevin Smith.

A motion was made by Councilman Mayfield to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of May 15, 2018 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Corpening. Carried 3 – 1, Councilman Ming abstained.

Old Business: Councilman Mayfield made a motion to accept and approve the boat bid from Steve Vandevord in the amount \$251.47 for the purchase of the boat. Motion second by Councilman Nedeau. Carried 4 – 0.

A motion made by Councilman Mayfield to approve \$130.00 to advertise Saturday In the Park in the Osage County Herald Chronicle. Motion second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4-0.

New Business: Councilman Ming made a motion to approve \$47,000.00 for purchase of 2, 240 tons of small rock to chip seal the streets. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Ming made a motion at 7:44 p.m. to go into a 15-minute executive session to discuss non-elected personnel with James Palacio present. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0. Returned to regular session at 7:59 p.m.

Councilman Nedeau made a motion to approve that whomever on the council would like a key to the padlocks, to sign document and check key out. Motion second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Ming made a motion for Mark Hoskin and Briar Long to begin a 90-day probation period for the volunteer fire department. Motion second by Councilman Nedeau. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Nedeau made a motion to approve the Fire Department to spend \$470.00 to get truck # 823 pump tested and certified. Carried 3 – 1. Councilman Mayfield opposed.

Councilman Ming made a motion to approve the Fire Department \$210.00 to purchase a 4-ton floor jack and a 4-way lug wrench. Motion was seconded by Councilman Corpening. Carried 4-0.

Councilman Ming made a motion to approve \$800.00 to purchase a dunk tank. Motion was second by Councilman Nedeau. Carried 3-1 with Councilman Corpening opposed.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve ordinances 19 & 20 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 - 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 8:31 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 - 0
