**Minutes for the Meeting  
of the Governing Body  
Tuesday July 17th, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Miner at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmembers; Jack Mayfield, Tim Nedeau, and Amy Miner. Councilman Ming and Councilman Corpening were absent. Employees; Ted McDaniel, James Palacio and Citizens; Justin Wheeler, Ken Croucher, Sherry Lester and Aulysha Lester.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Miner to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of July 3, 2018 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 2 – 0 – 1 (Councilman Nedeau abstained)

**Old Business:** 2019 budget completed with Cindy Jensen.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to publish notice for the public hearing for the 2019 budget. Motion second by Councilman Nedeau. Carried 3 – 0

Sherry Lester discussed Christmas Committee issues.

Aulysha Lester addressed council about providing things at Saturday in the Park for the older kids.

**New Business:** Councilwoman Miner made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 660 regulating traffic within the cooperate limits of the city. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 3 – 0

Councilwoman Miner made a motion to adopt ordinance No. 661 regulating public offences within the cooperate limits of the city as amended. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 3 – 0

Councilwoman Miner made a motion to make Darrell and Mark Sinclair permanent members of the volunteer fire department. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 3 – 0

Councilwoman Miner made a motion at 7:57 p.m. to go in to a five-minute executive session with Todd Luckman and Ken Croucher present to discuss non-elected personnel issue. Motion second by Councilman Nedeau. Carried 3 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:02 p.m.

Councilwoman Miner made a motion at 8:17 p.m. to take a five-minute break. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 3 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:22 p.m.

Councilman Nedeau made a motion at 8:24 p.m. to go into a fifteen-minute executive session with Todd Luckman, Bobi Morris and the right to call Ted McDaniel in to discuss elected personnel issue. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 3 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:39 p.m.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to allow any out of town water customer that also has all other city utility services be charged the in-town water rate. Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve ordinances 24 & 25 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 3 - 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 8:57 p.m. Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 3 - 0
