**Minutes for the Meeting  
of the Governing Body  
Tuesday August 21, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Miner at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmembers; Randy Ming, Tim Nedeau, Amy Miner, Jack Mayfield and Val Corpening. Employees; Ted McDaniel, James Palacio and Bobi Morris. Citizens; Justin Wheeler, Dan Rukes, Ken Croucher, Lois Berry, Trent Frye and Sherry Lester.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Miner to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of August 7, 2018 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0

**Old Business:** Drainage at W 5<sup>th</sup> and W Elm streets tabled.

**New Business:** Dan Rukes addressed the council about sponsoring ads for the school district activities in the Osage County Herald Chronicle.

Councilman Nedeau made a motion to place eleven (11) ads for \$280.00 in the Osage County Herald Chronicle. Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Failed 2 – 3 (Ming, Mayfield, Corpening)

Sherry Lester asked to have alcohol on the city premises during a fund-raising ball tournament.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve alcohol on the premises and wave the application fee. Motion second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

Ken Croucher asked for approval to buy batteries for the Zoll monitor.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve the purchase of two (2) used batteries for \$97.00 each from Elecotek. Motion was second by Councilman Corpening. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Corpening made a motion to approve the purchase of street oil for \$13,210.00 Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve a \$200.00 increase to petty cash. Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0

Councilwoman Miner made a motion at 7:45 p.m. to go in to a five-minute executive session with Todd Luckman present for attorney/client privilege. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 7:50 p.m.

Councilman Corpening made a motion at 7:55 p.m. to go in to a five-minute executive session with Todd Luckman present to discuss non-elected personnel. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:00 p.m.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve ordinances 31 & 32 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 8:12 p.m. Motion was second by Councilwoman Miner. Carried 5 – 0
